## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, further defining "soldier."
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 7101 of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania
- 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 7 § 7101. Soldier defined.
- 8 As used in this chapter, "soldier" means a person who served
- 9 OR HEREAFTER SERVES in the armed forces of the United States, or <-
- 10 in any women's organization officially connected therewith,
- 11 during any war or armed conflict in which the United States
- 12 engaged[, or] AND WHO WAS RELEASED FROM ACTIVE DUTY UNDER
- 13 HONORABLE CONDITIONS, OTHER THAN FROM PERIODS OF ACTIVE DUTY FOR

- 1 TRAINING, OR WITH AN HONORABLE DISCHARGE FROM SUCH SERVICE, OR A
- 2 PERSON who so served or hereafter serves in the armed forces of
- 3 the United States, or in any women's organization officially
- 4 connected therewith, since July 27, 1953, including service in
- 5 Vietnam, and who has an honorable discharge from such service.
- 6 The term includes those who served honorably in an active duty <-
- 7 <u>status for a period of not less than six months regardless of</u>
- 8 <u>fulfillment of their initial contractual enlistment.</u> <u>QUALIFYING</u> <--
- 9 PERIODS OF SERVICE DURING A WAR OR ARMED CONFLICT, FOR PURPOSES
- 10 OF THIS PROVISION, WILL BE DESIGNATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 11 MILITARY AND VETERANS AFFAIRS.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
