Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, further defining "collectible motor vehicle"; 3 defining "I CAR"; further providing for application for certificate of title, for transfer of vehicle ownership and for reconstructed vehicles; providing for titling and 5 inspection of reconstructed, modified and specially 7 constructed vehicles AND FOR ADVISORY PANEL; further 8 providing for required registration and certificate of title-9 providing for fees for reconstructed, modified and specially constructed vehicle inspection; further providing for the fee 10 for identification cards;, for VEHICLES EXEMPT FROM 11 REGISTRATION, FOR ANTIQUE, CLASSIC AND COLLECTIBLE PLATES, 12 13 FOR SAFETY INSPECTION CRITERIA FOR STREET RODS AND FOR 14 LIMITED LIABILITY OF INSPECTION STATION OR MECHANIC; 15 providing for certificate of appointment for ENHANCED VEHICLE 16 SAFETY INSPECTION FOR reconstructed vehicle inspection sites; 17 and further providing for issuance of certificate of inspection and for State replacement vehicle identification 18 19 number plate.
