14	Newly purchased vehiclesA newly purchased vehicle may be
15	driven without a current inspection certificate for ten days
16	after [sale or resale or] entry into this Commonwealth[,

18	sold or resold in this Commonwealth by a dealer.

2	Section 2. Title 75 is amended by adding a section to read:
3	<u>§</u> 4703.1. Current inspection certificate for newly purchased
4	vehicles.
5	(a) General ruleNo dealer may sell or resell a motor
6	vehicle unless the inspection certificate is valid for a period
7	of 12 months from the month in which the sale or resale occurs.
8	(b) PenaltyA dealer who violates this section commits a
9	summary offense.

10 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
