- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for period of revocation or
- 3 suspension of operating privilege.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1541 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 8 § 1541. Period of disqualification, revocation or suspension of
- 9 operating privilege.
- 10 * * *
- 11 (e) Request for hearing. -- A person whose operating privilege
- 12 has been suspended or revoked may request AT ANY TIME DURING THE <-
- 13 SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION, and the department shall provide, a
- 14 hearing if the person believes that credit toward the person's
- 15 suspension or revocation has not been given by the department
- 16 under section 1540. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE ITS FINAL RULING

- 1 WITHIN 60 DAYS FOLLOWING THE HEARING OR THE SUBMISSION OF ANY
- 2 <u>POSTHEARING FILINGS</u>.
- 3 SECTION 2. THE FOLLOWING SHALL APPLY:
- 4 (1) THE PROVISIONS OF 67 PA. CODE § 491.3(B)(2) ARE
- 5 ABROGATED.
- 6 (2) ALL OTHER REGULATIONS ARE ABROGATED TO THE EXTENT OF
- 7 ANY INCONSISTENCY WITH THE ADDITION OF 75 PA.C.S. § 1541(E).
- 8 Section 2 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days. <----
