Selling or furnishing liquor or malt or brewed beverages to minors resulting in injury or death. 10 (a) Bodily injury. -- A person commits a misdemeanor of the 11 second degree if that person sells or furnishes any liquor or 12 13 any malt or brewed beverage to a person who is under 21 years of 14 age and who suffers or causes another person to suffer bodily injury as a result of ingesting that liquor or malt or brewed 15

- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
