AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," providing payments to school districts for Limited English Proficiency programs.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a section to read:

Section 2504.4. Payments on Account of Limited English Proficiency Programs.--Every school district which enrolls students in a program or programs for students with Limited English Proficiency (LEP) shall be reimbursed for each student enrolled in 2002-2003, and each school year thereafter, payable in the succeeding school year, an amount equal to one thousand dollars $(\$ 1,000)$ per student multiplied by the market value personal income aid ratio of the school district.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
