AN ACT

1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, expanding the definition and hunting privileges of
3 military personnel.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 2702(c) of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 2702. Residents.

9 * * *

10 (c) Military personnel [stationed in Commonwealth].--Any
11 person regularly enrolled in any branch of the armed forces of
12 the United States or in the United States Coast Guard and
13 [officially stationed and quartered within this Commonwealth 30
14 or more days preceding] on full-time active duty on the date of

1 application shall be a resident for the purpose of this title.

3 Section 2. Section 2706(e) of Title 34, added December 30,
4 2003 (P.L. , No.63), is amended to read:

5 § 2706. Resident license and fee exemptions.

6 * * *

7 (e) Military personnel hunting licenses.--Resident military
8 personnel hunting licenses shall be issued by the commission or
9 county treasurer to persons who satisfy all of the following
10 requirements:

11 (1) Are residents of [this Commonwealth] the United
12 States.

13 (2) Are on active and full-time duty in the United
14 States Armed Forces.

15 [(3) Are assigned to a facility outside this
16 Commonwealth.

17 (4) Are on temporary leave in this Commonwealth.]

18 Such persons shall comply with the regulations of the
19 commission.

20 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
