16	Section 1. The act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), known

21	or medical expense insurance policy, hospital or medical service

- 2 policy or other insurance contract of this type, including a
- 3 group insurance plan or self-insurance plan that provides

- 6 2004, shall provide coverage of perioperative services rendered
- 7 by a registered nurse first assistant. Payments for registered

- 10 other heath care providers paid for such services.
- 11 (b) As used in this section:
- 12 (1) "Perioperative services" means preoperative,
- 13 <u>intraopertive and postoperative nursing care provided to</u>
- 14 surgical patients.
- 15 (2) "Registered nurse first assistant" means a person who:
- 16 (i) is licensed as a registered nurse in accordance with the
- 17 laws of this Commonwealth;
- 18 (ii) is experienced in perioperative services; and
- 19 (iii) has completed a national certification program of
- 20 perioperative services.
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
