A RESOLUTION

1 Observing the week of May 17 through 23, 2003, as "National Safe
2 Boating Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Each year 2.5 million people participate in boating
4 in this Commonwealth; and

5 WHEREAS, Each year an average of 12.5 people lose their lives
6 in boating accidents; and

7 WHEREAS, Paddling on Pennsylvania's waterways is becoming
8 more popular; and

9 WHEREAS, In 2002, nine paddlers died in accidents; and

10 WHEREAS, Use of United States Coast Guard-approved life
11 jackets and participation in boating safety courses have been
12 shown to save lives and minimize the risks associated with

1 boating and water sports; therefore be it

2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives observe the week
3 of May 17 through 23, 2003, as "National Safe Boating Week" in
4 Pennsylvania and encourage all boaters to increase their
5 knowledge of boating and use United States Coast Guard-approved
6 life jackets at all times.
