A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the month of May 2004 as "Stroke Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Every 45 seconds someone in the United States
- 4 experiences a stroke; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Stroke is the third leading cause of death in
- 6 America, killing 160,000 people annually, and a leading cause of
- 7 adult disability; and
- 8 WHEREAS, There are more than 4.8 million stroke survivors in
- 9 the United States, two-thirds of whom live with moderate to
- 10 severe disabilities; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The United States will spend an estimated \$53.6

- 1 billion in direct and indirect costs on stroke in 2004; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Stroke symptoms include sudden trouble talking,
- 3 walking or seeing and sudden, severe headache with no known
- 4 cause; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Stroke is one of the most preventable of all life-
- 6 threatening health problems, yet many Americans cannot identify
- 7 a single symptom of stroke and many do not discuss stroke risks
- 8 with their primary health care providers; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Public awareness of stroke risks and warning signs
- 10 is essential to prevention and early treatment; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Prompt treatment of stroke can save lives and reduce
- 12 disability; and
- 13 WHEREAS, National Stroke Association observes "National
- 14 Stroke Awareness Month" in May and urges people to take charge
- 15 of their health by asking their doctors about stroke risks and
- 16 adopting healthy lifestyles; therefore be it
- 17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 18 month of May 2004 as "Stroke Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania
- 19 and encourage all citizens to ask their doctors about stroke
- 20 prevention and warning signs.
