1 income growth, the crime rate, the cost of doing business and 2 the cost of living. Smaller metro areas were defined as those 3 with populations under 335,000; and

WHEREAS, The metropolitan area ranked second among the smaller metros, 128 metros were considered, in the number of advanced degree holders per 100,000 people, and had the secondlowest crime rate; and
