AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for
- 3 loss of property rights to the Commonwealth.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 6801(h) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 6801. Loss of property rights to Commonwealth.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (h) Authorization to utilize property.--The district
- 11 attorney and the Attorney General shall utilize forfeited
- 12 property or proceeds thereof for the purpose of enforcing the
- 13 provisions of The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and
- 14 Cosmetic Act, 18 Pa.C.S. (relating to crimes and offenses) and
- 15 <u>75 Pa.C.S. (relating to vehicles)</u>. In appropriate cases, the
- 16 district attorney and the Attorney General may designate
- 17 proceeds from forfeited property to be utilized by community-
- 18 based drug and crime-fighting programs and for relocation and

- 1 protection of witnesses in criminal cases.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
