AN ACT

1 Amending the act of August 21, 1953 (P.L.1323, No.373), entitled
2 "An act concerning notaries public; and amending, revising,
3 consolidating and changing the law relating thereto," further
4 providing for eligibility.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 3 of the act of August 21, 1953
8 (P.L.1323, No.373), known as The Notary Public Law, amended
9 December 9, 2002 (P.L.1269, No.151), is amended to read:

10 Section 3. Eligibility.-- (a) Any person who is eighteen
11 (18) years of age or over, who resides or is employed within
12 this Commonwealth, who is a citizen of the United States and who
13 is of good character, integrity and ability shall be eligible
14 for the office of notary public.

15 (b) Any person who is a notary public and who resides
16 outside this Commonwealth shall be deemed to have irrevocably
17 appointed the Secretary of the Commonwealth as the person's
18 agent upon whom may be served any summons, subpoena, order or

1 other process.

2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
