- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 5511(q) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition and the
- 8 section is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 9 § 5511. Cruelty to animals.

- 11 (c.1) Cruelty to elephants to maintain obedience. -- A person
- 12 commits a summary offense if he utilizes, or allows to be
- 13 utilized, a bull hook to beat, discipline, prod, train, yank or
- 14 otherwise control any elephant.

- 16 (q) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 17 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 18 subsection:

- 2 "Bull hook." A sharpened steel hook at the end of a long
- 3 <u>handle or stick; an ankus; an elephant goad; an elephant hook.</u>

- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 5
