## AN ACT

1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, further providing for license costs and fees.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
4 hereby enacts as follows:

7 SECTION 1. SECTION 2706 OF TITLE 34 OF THE PENNSYLVANIA <—  
8 CONSOLIDATED STATUTES IS AMENDED BY ADDING A SUBSECTION TO READ:  
9 § 2706. RESIDENT LICENSE AND FEE EXEMPTIONS.

11 (E) MILITARY PERSONNEL HUNTING LICENSES.--RESIDENT MILITARY  
12 PERSONNEL HUNTING LICENSES SHALL BE ISSUED BY THE COMMISSION OR  
13 COUNTY TREASURER TO PERSONS WHO SATISFY ALL OF THE FOLLOWING  
14 REQUIREMENTS:

15 (1) ARE RESIDENTS OF THIS COMMONWEALTH.

16 (2) ARE ON ACTIVE AND FULL-TIME DUTY IN THE UNITED

1       STATES ARMED FORCES.

2           (3) ARE ASSIGNED TO A FACILITY OUTSIDE THIS  
3       COMMONWEALTH.

4           (4) ARE ON TEMPORARY LEAVE IN THIS COMMONWEALTH.  
5       SUCH PERSONS SHALL COMPLY WITH THE REGULATIONS OF THE  
6       COMMISSION.

7       SECTION 2. SECTION 2709(A) OF TITLE 34 IS AMENDED TO READ:

8       § 2709. License costs and fees.

9       (a) License costs.--Any person who qualifies under the  
10      provisions of this chapter shall be issued the applicable  
11      license upon payment of the following costs and the issuing  
12      agent's fee:

13           (1) (i) Junior resident hunting - \$5.

14                   (ii) Junior resident combination hunting and  
15      furtaker - \$8.

16           (2) (i) Adult resident hunting - \$19.

17                   (ii) Resident military personnel hunting - \$10.

18           (3) (i) Senior resident hunting - \$12.

19                   (ii) Senior lifetime resident hunting - \$50.

20                   (iii) Senior lifetime resident combination hunting  
21      and furtaker - \$100.

22           (4) Bear hunting:

23                   (i) Resident - \$15.

24                   (ii) Nonresident - \$35.

25           (5) Antlerless deer:

26                   (i) Resident, including resident military, resident  
27      disabled veteran and landowner - \$5.

28                   (ii) Nonresident - \$25.

29           (6) Archery deer:

- 15       (15) Adult nonresident furtaker - \$80.
- 16       (16) Junior nonresident furtaker - \$40.
- 17       (17) Resident disabled veteran hunting or furtaker under
- 18       section 2706(b) (relating to disabled veterans) - no cost.
- 19       (18) Replacement license - \$5. Antlerless deer and bear
- 20       licenses shall be replaced by the original issuing agent
- 21       only.
- 22       (19) Owners or possessors of land open to public hunting
- 23       under section 2706(d) (relating to owners or possessors of
- 24       land open to public hunting) - \$3.
- 25       (20) Migratory game bird hunting license:
- 26           (i) Resident - \$2.
- 27           (ii) Nonresident - \$5.
- 28       (21) Elk hunting license:
- 29           (i) Resident - \$25.
- 30           (ii) Nonresident - \$250.
