9	(a) Offense definedA person commits the offense of
10	environmental harassment if the person communicates to another
11	person a threat to commit or cause to be committed a crime of
12	violence dangerous to human life or destructive to property or
13	business practices, for the purpose of expressing a perspective
14	on an environmental or natural resource issue and the reasonable
15	consequence of the threat is one of the following:
16	(1) To cause personal injury or damage to property or
17	business.
18	(2) To cause interruption of business which results in

2	(b)	RestitutionA	person	convicted	under	this	section

3 shall, in addition to any other sentence imposed, be sentenced

4 to pay the threatened person or business the amount of actual

- 5 loss and restitution in an amount equal to the cost of
- 6 interruption of business directly related to the act of
- 7 <u>environmental harassment.</u>
- 8 (c) Grading.--An offense under this section is a misdemeanor
- 9 <u>of the third degree.</u>
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
