Registration. 9 Ten-year registration. -- The following individuals shall 10 be required to register with the Pennsylvania State Police for a period of ten years: 11 12 (1)Individuals convicted of any of the following offenses: 13 18 Pa.C.S. § 2901 (relating to kidnapping) where the 14 15 victim is a minor. 18 Pa.C.S. § 3124.2 (relating to institutional sexual 16 <u>assault)</u>. 17
