- 8 Section 1. Section 5(a) of the act of July 22, 1974
- 9 (P.L.589, No.205), known as the Unfair Insurance Practices Act,
- 10 is amended by adding paragraphs to read:
- 11 Section 5. Unfair Methods of Competition and Unfair or
- 12 Deceptive Acts or Practices Defined. -- (a) "Unfair methods of
- 13 competition" and "unfair or deceptive acts or practices" in the
- 14 business of insurance means:
- 15 * * *
- 16 (15) Cancelling or refusing to renew a person's insurance on
- 17 the basis of inquiries from that person that do not result in a
- 18 claim.
- 19 (16) Cancelling or refusing to renew a person's insurance

- 1 because another claim was filed without giving written notice
- 2 prior to that claim that another claim filed by the policyholder
- 3 may cause a cancellation or refusal to renew.

- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
