AN ACT

1 Designating a portion of State Route 1014 in Cumberland County  
2 as the Senator John D. Hopper Memorial Bypass.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Senator John D. Hopper Memorial Bypass in Cumberland  
6 County.

7 (a) Designation.--The section of State Route 1014 in  
8 Cumberland County from the western terminus of the M. Harvey  
9 Taylor Bridge in Wormleysburg Borough, Cumberland County, to the  
10 intersection of 21st Street and State Route 1014 in East  
11 Pennsboro Township, Cumberland County, is hereby designated the  
12 Senator John D. Hopper Memorial Bypass.

13 (b) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and  
14 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to  
15 traffic in both directions on the highway.

16 Section 2. Effective date.

1       This act shall take effect immediately.
