## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Directing the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee to study
- and report on health insurance discount options for child-
- 3 care providers through group pooling.
- 4 WHEREAS, Thirty-five percent of child-care workers have
- 5 access to health insurance benefits; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Nearly two-thirds of all children under five years
- 7 of age are in child care; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Consistency in child care has been found to be
- 9 extremely important to a child's well-being; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Low pay and lack of health insurance benefits is
- 11 causing a higher turnover rate in the child-care field;
- 12 therefore be it
- 13 RESOLVED, That the Senate direct the Legislative Budget and
- 14 Finance Committee to study and report on health insurance
- 15 discount options for child-care providers through group pooling;
- 16 and be it further
- 17 RESOLVED, That the committee report its findings, together
- 18 with recommendations for remedial legislation or other

- 1 appropriate action, to the Senate within one year of the
- 2 adoption of this resolution.
