2	OTHER MANMADE DEBRIS WITHIN THE WATERWAY; IMPROVEMENTS TO
3	ELIMINATE ACID MINE DRAINAGE IMPACTS; AND FOR EXPENSES DIRECTLY
4	RELATED TO ADMINISTRATION AND OPERATION, INCLUDING, BUT NOT
5	LIMITED TO, RENT AND OFFICE ITEMS. SUCH APPROPRIATIONS MAY NOT
6	BE USED TO UNDERTAKE LITIGATION AGAINST ANY MUNICIPAL
7	CORPORATION OR TO SEEK REDRESS AGAINST ANY INDIVIDUAL LANDOWNER.
8	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
