AN ACT

Amending the act of June 26, 2001 (P.L.755, No.77), entitled "An 2 act establishing a special fund and account for money 3 received by the Commonwealth from the Master Settlement 4 Agreement with tobacco manufacturers; providing for home and 5 community-based care, for tobacco use prevention and cessation efforts, for Commonwealth universal research 7 enhancement, for hospital uncompensated care, for health investment insurance, for medical assistance for workers with 8 9 disabilities, for regional biotechnology research centers, 10 for the HealthLink Program, for community-based health care assistance programs, for PACE reinstatement and PACENET 11 12 expansion, for medical education loan assistance and for 13 percentage allocation and appropriation of moneys, "providing 14 for a designated percentage of Master Settlement Agreement 15 funds to be utilized for cancer research facilities; 16 establishing the Pennsylvania Cancer Research Fund; providing 17 for duties of the Department of Health; authorizing an advisory board and providing for its powers and duties. 18 19 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 20 hereby enacts as follows: 21 Section 1. The act of June 26, 2001 (P.L.755, No.77), known 22 as the Tobacco Settlement Act, is amended by adding a chapter to 23 read:

1 <u>CANCER RESEARCH</u>

- 2 <u>Section 1001. Scope.</u>
- 3 <u>This chapter deals with cancer research.</u>
- 4 Section 1002. Definitions.
- 5 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 6 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 7 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 8 <u>"Department." The Department of Health of the Commonwealth.</u>
- 9 <u>"Fund." The Pennsylvania Cancer Research Fund established in</u>
- 10 section 1003 (relating to fund).
- 11 Section 1003. Fund.
- 12 (a) Establishment.--There is established in the State
- 13 Treasury the Pennsylvania Cancer Research Fund. The money of the
- 14 fund is appropriated on a continuing basis to the department for
- 15 the purposes set forth in this chapter.
- 16 (b) Funding. -- Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 17 act to the contrary, beginning July 1, 2005, and each fiscal
- 18 year thereafter, 25% of all money received by the Commonwealth
- 19 under the Master Settlement Agreement shall be deposited into
- 20 the fund for issuance of grants in accordance with this chapter.
- 21 <u>Section 1004</u>. <u>Duties of department</u>.
- The department shall, in cooperation with the advisory board,
- 23 accept, evaluate and fund research projects designed to
- 24 determine the causes and treatment of all forms of cancer. The
- 25 <u>department shall issue grants for this purpose. Grants shall be</u>
- 26 paid from the fund.
- 27 Section 1005. Advisory board.
- 28 (a) Authorization. -- The Physician General shall appoint an
- 29 <u>individual from each of the following to serve on an advisory</u>
- 30 board:

- 1 (1) The University of Pittsburgh Cancer Institute.
- 2 (2) The University of Pennsylvania Cancer Center.
- 3 (3) The Pennsylvania State Cancer Institute.
- 4 (4) The Fox Chase Cancer Center.
- 5 (5) The Kimmel Cancer Center at Thomas Jefferson
- 6 <u>University.</u>
- 7 (6) The Temple University Cancer Center.
- 8 <u>(7) The Lake Erie College of Osteopathic Medicine.</u>
- 9 <u>(8) The Wistar Institute.</u>
- 10 No member shall be entitled to receive any compensation for
- 11 participation on the advisory board but may be entitled to
- 12 receive reimbursement for reasonable expenses incurred for that
- 13 participation.
- 14 (b) Cochairpersons.--The Physician General and one
- 15 <u>individual on the advisory board, who in the first year of the</u>
- 16 <u>fund's operation shall be selected from among the members, shall</u>
- 17 <u>serve as cochairpersons. The selected chairperson shall serve in</u>
- 18 that capacity for a term of three years. The Physician General
- 19 shall serve ex officio.
- 20 (c) Duties of the advisory board. -- The advisory board shall
- 21 review project proposals for research study grants from the fund
- 22 and shall recommend approval of proposals to the department. The
- 23 advisory board shall devise a formula for distribution of fund
- 24 moneys for both long-term and short-term research projects.
- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
