## AN ACT

- Amending Title 62 (Procurement) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
  Statutes, prohibiting Commonwealth agencies from awarding
  contracts to bidders engaged in outsourcing of jobs or
  functions.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 62 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 109. Prohibiting contract awards to bidders that outsource.
- 10 No Commonwealth agency may award a contract on or after the
- 11 effective date of this section to any bidder, offeror or other
- 12 person that has had a net loss of one or more employees in the
- 13 United States within the three years prior to submitting its bid
- 14 or offer on the contract, which was caused by the relocation of
- 15 jobs previously performed at a physical location within the
- 16 boundaries of the United States to any physical location outside

- 1 of the boundaries of the United States.
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 30 days.
