AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the offense of 3 scattering rubbish. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 6501(b)(1) of Title 18 of the 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 8 § 6501. Scattering rubbish. 9 10 (b) Penalty.--A person who violates subsection (a)(1) or (2) is 11 guilty of a summary offense for the first offense and upon 12 13 conviction thereof shall be sentenced to: (i) pay a fine of not less than [\$50] \$250 nor more 14 than [\$300] \$500 [or to]; 15

(ii) imprisonment for not more than 90 days[, or

both.]<u>;</u> 1 (iii) not more than 90 days of community service; or 2 (iv) any combination of subparagraphs (i), (ii) and 3 <u>(iii).</u> 4 * * * 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 6
