AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying 3 and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and 7 imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations 9 and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and penalties," providing for contributions to the Lupus 10 Foundation of Pennsylvania of refunds by checkoff. 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- hereby enacts as follows: 13
- Section 1. The act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as 14
- 15 the Tax Reform Code of 1971, is amended by adding a section to

- 17 Section 315.8. Contributions for Lupus Foundation of
- Pennsylvania. -- (a) The department shall provide a space on the 18
- Pennsylvania individual income tax return form whereby an 19
- individual may voluntarily designate a contribution of any 20

- 1 amount desired to the Lupus Foundation of Pennsylvania.
- 2 (b) The amount so designated by an individual on the income
- 3 tax return form shall be deducted from the tax refund to which
- 4 <u>such individual is entitled and shall not constitute a charge</u>
- 5 against the income tax revenues due the Commonwealth.
- 6 (c) The department shall determine annually the total amount
- 7 <u>designated pursuant to this section, less reasonable</u>
- 8 administrative costs, and shall report such amount to the State
- 9 Treasurer, who shall transfer such amount from the General Fund
- 10 to the Lupus Foundation of Pennsylvania.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
