5	(b) Plate detailsThe special registration plate shall
6	display a set of jump wings and glider wings along with the
7	letters "ABN" followed by a series of five digits. The first two
8	or three digits of the five-digit series will denote the number
9	of the division under which the person served.
10	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
