- 1 WHO SATISFACTORILY COMPLETED THE PRESCRIBED PROFICIENCY TESTS
- 2 WHILE ASSIGNED OR ATTACHED TO AN AIRBORNE UNIT AND ANY OTHER
- 3 MILITARY PERSONNEL DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT TO BE
- 4 APPROPRIATELY CLASSIFIED AS A MEMBER OF A UNITED STATES MILITARY
- 5 AIRBORNE PARACHUTIST OR GLIDER UNIT.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
