Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for 3 compulsory arbitration. Compulsory arbitration. 10 (b) Limitations. -- No matter shall be referred under 11 12 subsection (a): 13 (1) which involves title to real property; or 14 (2) where the amount in controversy, exclusive of 15 interest and costs, exceeds[: 16 \$50,000 in judicial districts embracing first,

second, second class A or third class counties or home

- rule counties which but for the adoption of a home rule
