## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, further providing for persons with military
- 3 service-connected disabilities to receive property tax
- 4 exemptions.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby resolves as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 8 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 9 That section 2(c) of Article VIII be amended to read:
- 10 § 2. Exemptions and special provisions.
- 11 \* \* \*
- 12 (c) Citizens and residents of this Commonwealth, who served
- 13 in [any war or armed conflict in which the United States was
- 14 engaged] the armed forces of the United States and were
- 15 honorably discharged or released under honorable circumstances
- 16 from active service, shall be exempt from the payment of [all]

- 1 real property taxes upon the residence occupied by the said
- 2 citizens and residents of this Commonwealth imposed by the
- 3 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or any of its political
- 4 subdivisions if, as a result of military service, they are
- 5 blind, paraplegic or double or quadruple amputees or have a
- 6 service-connected disability declared by the United States
- 7 Veterans Administration or its successor to be a [total or 100%]
- 8 permanent disability[, and if the State Veterans' Commission
- 9 determines that such persons are in need of the tax exemptions
- 10 granted herein]. The percentage of exemption from real property
- 11 taxes shall be in direct proportion to the percentage of
- 12 <u>disability as determined by the United States Department of</u>
- 13 <u>Veterans Affairs or its successor.</u> This exemption shall be
- 14 extended to the unmarried surviving spouse upon the death of an
- 15 eligible veteran [provided that the State Veterans' Commission
- 16 determines that such person is in need of the exemption].
- 17 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General
- 18 Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the
- 19 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to
- 20 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article
- 21 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the
- 22 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in
- 23 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after
- 24 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.
- 25 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this
- 26 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the
- 27 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the
- 28 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the
- 29 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required
- 30 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such

- 1 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of
- 2 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the
- 3 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment
- 4 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first
- 5 primary, general or municipal election occurring at least three
- 6 months after the proposed constitutional amendment is passed by
- 7 the General Assembly.
