AN ACT

- 1 Making an appropriation to the Mercer Museum in Doylestown,
- 2 Pennsylvania, for operating expenses.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. The sum of $\frac{$160,000}{}$ \$178,000 is hereby
- 6 appropriated to the Mercer Museum in Doylestown, Pennsylvania,
- 7 for the fiscal year July 1, 2005, to June 30, 2006, for
- 8 operating expenses, including maintenance and the purchase of
- 9 apparatus, supplies and equipment.
- 10 Section 2. Payments to the Mercer Museum on account of the
- 11 appropriation provided in section 1 shall be made quarterly by
- 12 the Executive Director of the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum
- 13 Commission.
- 14 Section 3. The Mercer Museum shall provide full, complete
- 15 and accurate information as may be required by the Pennsylvania
- 16 Historical and Museum Commission or the chairman or the minority

- 1 chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the
- 2 chairman or the minority chairman of the Appropriations
- 3 Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 4 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005, or
- 5 immediately, whichever is later. IMMEDIATELY. <----
