AN ACT

L2	member of the Pennsylvania National Guard is called or ordered

into active Federal service or active State duty under orders

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authorized by law or a member of any reserve component is called 1 or ordered onto active duty, other than active duty for 2 3 training, the public or private employer of the member shall, at 4 no cost to the member, continue health insurance and other 5 benefits in effect for at least the first 30 days of the military duty. After the expiration of the first 30 days, the 6 7 public [or private] employer shall [give the member of the 8 National Guard or other reserve component the voluntary option of continuing such health insurance and other benefits in effect 9 10 at his own expense by paying for the insurance or benefits at 11 the same rates paid by the employer, and the insurance coverage shall continue], except for injuries incurred in the line of 12 13 military duty[.], provide, at no cost to the member, health insurance and other benefits for the member and the member's 14 15 dependents, as provided to active employees, for the period that the member is on active duty, unless the member declines such 16 17 coverage. If such member is employed by a private employer, the 18 Commonwealth shall, except for injuries incurred in the line of military duty, provide, at no cost to the member, health 19 20 insurance and other benefits for the member and the member's 21 dependents, as provided to Commonwealth employees through the 22 Pennsylvania Employee Benefit Trust Fund, for the period that 23 the member is on active duty, unless the member declines such 24 coverage.

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Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
