## AN ACT

- 1 Providing for the designation of the Keystone Building as the
- 2 Speaker James J. Manderino Office Building; and making a
- 3 repeal.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Keystone Building.
- 7 The Keystone Building in the City of Harrisburg is designated
- 8 as, and shall be referred to as, the Speaker James J. Manderino
- 9 Office Building.
- 10 Section 2. Repeal.
- 11 All acts and parts of acts are repealed insofar as they are
- 12 inconsistent with this act.
- 13 Section 3. Effective date.
