## AN ACT

- 1 Creating tax incentives for increasing workplace employment.
- 2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 3 hereby enacts as follows:
- 4 Section 1. Short title.
- 5 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Job
- 6 Incentives Act.
- 7 Section 2. Business tax credit.
- 8 A business paying taxes to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 may exclude 10% of taxes that would otherwise be due if, during
- 10 the course of its preceding taxable year, it increased its
- 11 workforce by at least 25% and each newly created position
- 12 remains filled for at least one full year.
- 13 Section 3. Retroactivity.
- 14 This act shall be retroactive to January 1, 2005.
- 15 Section 4. Expiration.
- 16 This act shall expire on December 31, 2010.

- 1 Section 5. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect immediately.
