## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the offense of
- 3 indecent assault.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3126(b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 3126. Indecent assault.
- 9 \* \* \*
- 10 (b) Grading.--Indecent assault under subsection (a)(7) is a
- 11 misdemeanor of the first degree[.], except where there is a
- 12 course of conduct, in which case it is a felony of the second
- 13 <u>degree</u>. Otherwise, indecent assault is a misdemeanor of the
- 14 second degree[.], except where there is a course of conduct, in
- 15 which case it is a felony of the third degree.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
