AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for the offense of assault
- 3 on law enforcement officer.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 2703.2. Assault on law enforcement officer.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- A person who is being held in official
- 10 custody of a law enforcement officer, whether or not charged
- 11 with or having been convicted of or sentenced for an offense in
- 12 this Commonwealth, commits a felony of the second degree if he
- 13 intentionally or knowingly causes another to come into contact
- 14 with blood, seminal fluid, saliva, urine or feces by throwing,
- 15 tossing, spitting or expelling such fluid or material when, at
- 16 the time of the offense, the person knew, had reason to know,
- 17 should have known or believed such fluid or material to have

- been obtained from an individual, including the person charged 1
- 2 under this section, infected by a communicable disease,
- including, but not limited to, human immunodeficiency virus 3
- (HIV) or hepatitis B. 4
- 5 (b) Definition. -- For purposes of this section, "law
- enforcement officer shall mean an officer of the Pennsylvania 6
- 7 State Police and a member of a police force employed by a city,
- township, incorporated town or borough or a regional police 8
- force in this Commonwealth.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 10
