## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 5 laws relating thereto," further providing for district 6 superintendents and assistant district superintendents. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 1075 of the act of March 10, 1949 9 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, amended January 14, 1970 (1969 P.L.468, No.192), is amended to 11 12 read: Section 1075. Salary .-- The board of school directors at any 13 14 convention electing a district superintendent or an assistant 15 district superintendent shall determine the amount of salary to 16 be paid such district superintendent or assistant district superintendent which compensation shall be paid out of the funds 17 of the district and shall not be more than the range of the 18 salary level provided in section 1075.1. If a district 19

- 1 superintendent or an assistant district superintendent is
- 2 employed in a joint school system including kindergarten or
- 3 grades 1 to 12, his salary shall be fixed by a majority vote of
- 4 all the school directors in the districts operating the joint
- 5 school systems, and shall be paid by the districts in the same
- 6 proportions as they contribute to the support of the joint
- 7 school.
- 8 [District superintendents and assistant district
- 9 superintendents shall be entitled to the following minimum
- 10 annual salaries:
- 11 (1) Assistant district superintendents having less than one
- 12 hundred (100) teachers under their supervision, nine thousand
- 13 dollars (\$9,000).
- 14 (2) Assistant district superintendents having one hundred
- 15 (100) teachers or more but less than three hundred (300)
- 16 teachers under their supervision, ten thousand dollars
- 17 (\$10,000).
- 18 (3) Assistant district superintendents having three hundred
- 19 (300) or more teachers under their supervision, eleven thousand
- 20 dollars (\$11,000).
- 21 (4) District superintendents having less than one hundred
- 22 (100) teachers under their supervision, thirteen thousand
- 23 dollars (\$13,000).
- 24 (5) District superintendents having one hundred (100)
- 25 teachers or more but less than three (300) teachers under their
- 26 supervision, fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000).
- 27 (6) District superintendents having three hundred (300) or
- 28 more teachers under their supervision, fifteen thousand dollars
- 29 (\$15,000).]
- 30 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:

- 1 Section 1075.1. Salary to be Established by Secretary of
- 2 Education. -- (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this act
- 3 to the contrary, a district superintendent or assistant district
- 4 superintendent elected by the board of school directors of any
- 5 school district shall be considered an officer of the
- 6 Commonwealth and shall be subject to a range of salary and
- 7 benefit levels, except as provided for in subsection (d),
- 8 <u>established annually by the Secretary of Education after</u>
- 9 <u>consultation with the State Board of Education.</u>
- 10 (b) Salaries of district superintendents and assistant
- 11 <u>district superintendents shall be paid out of the funds of the</u>
- 12 <u>district and may not exceed the range of salary levels</u>
- 13 <u>established by the Secretary of Education. Any district</u>
- 14 superintendent or assistant district superintendent who receives
- 15 <u>a salary under professional contract prior to the effective date</u>
- 16 of this section which is higher than the range of the salary
- 17 levels established by the secretary may receive the higher
- 18 salary for the remainder of the professional contract. However,
- 19 upon the expiration of the professional contract, the salary
- 20 <u>shall be equal to the range of salary levels established by the</u>
- 21 <u>secretary</u>.
- 22 (c) When establishing a range of salary levels for district
- 23 superintendents and assistant district superintendents, the
- 24 Secretary of Education shall take into consideration the class
- 25 of the school district and years of experience as a district
- 26 superintendent or assistant district superintendent.
- 27 (d) District superintendents and assistant superintendents
- 28 shall continue to be considered school employes for the purpose
- 29 of membership, contributions and benefits under 24 Pa.C.S. Ch.
- 30 83 (relating to membership, contributions and benefits).

- 1 Section 3. Section 1077 of the act, amended January 16, 1974
- 2 (P.L.1, No.1), is amended to read:
- 3 Section 1077. Term and Salary of Assistants.--Assistant
- 4 district superintendents may serve through the term of the
- 5 district superintendent, or enter a contract for a term of from
- 6 three to five years at salaries paid by the district, and fixed
- 7 by a majority vote of the whole board of school directors prior
- 8 to their election which salaries shall not exceed the salary
- 9 <u>levels provided in section 1075.1</u>.
- 10 At a regular meeting of the board of school directors
- 11 occurring at least one hundred fifty (150) days prior to the
- 12 expiration date of the term of office of the assistant district
- 13 superintendent, the agenda shall include an item requiring
- 14 affirmative action by five (5) or more members of the board of
- 15 school directors to notify the assistant district superintendent
- 16 that the board intends to retain him for a further term of from
- 17 three (3) to five (5) years or that another or other candidates
- 18 will be considered for the office. In the event that the board
- 19 fails to take such action at a regular meeting of the board of
- 20 school directors occurring at least one hundred fifty (150) days
- 21 prior to the expiration date of the term of office of the
- 22 assistant district superintendent, he shall continue in office
- 23 for a further term of similar length to that which he is
- 24 serving.
- 25 Section 4. All acts and parts of acts are repealed insofar
- 26 as they are inconsistent with this act.
- 27 Section 5. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
