10	(a) Imposition A violation by the agency of section
11	7313(6) (relating to powers and duties) that results in losses
12	to a political subdivision or its residents shall be punishable
13	by a fine in the amount of the damages incurred. The fine shall
14	be awarded to the political subdivision, and the political
15	subdivision shall allocate the proceeds of the fine among the
16	aggrieved parties.
17	(b) ProcedureThe district attorney shall enforce the
18	<u>fine.</u>
19	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
