## A RESOLUTION

1 Directing the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee to study  
2 the revenues generated by NASCAR racing at the Pocono  
3 Raceway.

4 WHEREAS, The National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing  
5 (NASCAR) annually conducts racing events, namely the Pocono 500  
6 and the Pennsylvania 500, at the Pocono Raceway, generating  
7 substantial revenues for this Commonwealth; therefore be it

8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives direct the  
9 Legislative Budget and Finance Committee to complete a study of  
10 the revenues generated by the Pocono 500 and the Pennsylvania  
11 500; and be it further

12 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee  
13 report its findings and recommendations to the House of  
14 Representatives as soon as possible.
