## AN ACT

10	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
11	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a

13	Section 507.1. State-Mandated ProgramsNotwithstanding any
14	other provisions of this act, the board of school directors in
15	any school district shall not be required to implement any
16	mandatory educational program enacted through statute,
17	regulation or standards until such time as the General Assembly
18	enacts a method to pay for, and an appropriation sufficient to
19	fund, the additional costs of the program.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
