12	hereby enacts as follows:
13	Section 1. The act of July 19, 1979 (P.L.130, No.48), known
14	as the Health Care Facilities Act, is amended by adding a
15	section to read:
16	Section 813.1. Quality assurance inspections.
17	Notwithstanding any other inspection performed by the
18	department under this chapter, the department shall on an annual
19	basis conduct random, unannounced inspections of 25% of the
20	licensed health care facilities within this Commonwealth. The
21	purpose of the inspection shall be to ensure that health care

- 1 facilities and services continue to meet high quality standards
- 2 and that all citizens receive the humane, courteous and
- 3 dignified treatment and the quality care and services to which
- 4 they are entitled.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
