AN ACT

Amending the act of August 15, 1961 (P.L.987, No.442), entitled 2 "An act relating to public works contracts; providing for 3 prevailing wages; imposing duties upon the Secretary of Labor and Industry; providing remedies, penalties and repealing 5 existing laws," further providing for the definition of 6 "public work." The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 2(5) of the act of August 15, 1961 9 10 (P.L.987, No.442), known as the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage 11 Act, amended August 9, 1963 (P.L.653, No.342), is amended to 12 read: Section 2. Definitions. -- As used in this act--13 14 15 "Public work" means construction, reconstruction, 16 demolition, alteration and/or repair work other than maintenance work, done under contract and paid for in whole or in part out 17 of the funds of a public body where the estimated cost of the 18

total project is in excess of [twenty-five thousand dollars

- 1 (\$25,000)] five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000), but shall
- 2 not include work performed under a rehabilitation or manpower
- 3 training program. Commencing on January 1, 2006, the prevailing
- 4 wage exemption for a public work covered by this clause shall be
- 5 updated by the Secretary of Labor and Industry as of January 1
- 6 of each year. The update shall be equal to the percentage change
- 7 <u>in the Statewide average weekly wage. Such updates shall be</u>
- 8 <u>cumulative</u>.

- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
