## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- 4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- 5 laws relating thereto, "further providing for display of
- 6 United States Flag and development of patriotism.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 771(c) of the act of March 10, 1949
- 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949,
- 11 amended December 9, 2002 (P.L.1334, No.157), is amended to read:
- 12 Section 771. Display of United States Flag; Development of
- 13 Patriotism.--\* \* \*
- 14 (c) [(1)] All supervising officers and teachers in charge
- 15 of public[, private or parochial] schools shall cause the Flag
- 16 of the United States of America to be displayed in every
- 17 classroom during the hours of each school day and shall provide
- 18 for the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance or the national

- 1 anthem in each classroom at the beginning of each school day.
- 2 [Students] <u>Under no circumstances may any teacher, school</u>
- 3 administrator, board of school directors or other person waive
- 4 the requirements of this paragraph. However, students may
- 5 decline to recite the Pledge of Allegiance and may refrain from
- 6 saluting the flag on the basis of religious conviction or
- 7 personal belief. [The supervising officer of a school subject to
- 8 the requirements of this subsection shall provide written
- 9 notification to the parents or guardian of any student who
- 10 declines to recite the Pledge of Allegiance or who refrains from
- 11 saluting the flag.
- 12 (2) This subsection shall not apply to any private or
- 13 parochial school for which the display of the flag, the
- 14 recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance or the salute of the flag
- 15 violates the religious conviction on which the school is based.]

- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
