AN ACT

1 Designating SR 65 in the vicinity of Leetsdale, Allegheny
2 County, as the James E. Russo Highway.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. James E. Russo Highway.

6 (a) Declaration of policy.--The General Assembly finds and
7 declares that:

8 (1) James E. Russo served as an Allegheny County
9 district justice for 29 years.

10 ~~(2) Judge Russo graduated cum laude from St. John's <—~~
11 ~~University and received his J.D. from Columbus School of Law,~~
12 ~~Catholic University of America. He was appointed Judge of the~~
13 ~~Commonwealth Court of Municipal Discipline in 1998.~~

14 (2) JUDGE RUSSO WAS APPOINTED AS THE FIRST DISTRICT <—
15 JUSTICE TO SERVE ON THE FORMER JUDICIAL CONDUCT BOARD,
16 PREDECESSOR TO THE COURT OF JUDICIAL DISCIPLINE OF

1 PENNSYLVANIA, IN 1998.

2 (b) Designation.--State Route 65 in the vicinity of
3 Leetsdale, Allegheny County, shall be designated as the James E.
4 Russo Highway in honor of the late James E. Russo.

5 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
6 maintain signs which shall display the name of the highway
7 designated in subsection (b) at each end of the designated
8 segment.

9 Section 2. Effective date.

10 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
