AN ACT

Amending the act of June 29, 1996 (P.L.434, No.67), entitled, as amended, "An act to enhance job creation and economic 3 development by providing for an annual financing strategy, 4 for opportunity grants, for job creation tax credits, for small business assistance, for the Small Business Advocacy 6 Council, for a family savings program, for industrial 7 development assistance, for community development bank grants 8 and loans and for tax-exempt bond allocation; conferring powers and duties on various administrative agencies and 9 authorities; further providing for various funds; and making 10 repeals," further providing for approved courses and for 11 12 eligible interns. 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. Sections 3102(c) and 3106(a) of the act of June 29, 1996 (P.L.434, No.67), known as the Job Enhancement Act, 16 17 added November 6, 2003 (P.L.205, No.34), are amended to read: Section 3102. - 10 agency, but participation shall not be limited to those students
