AN ACT

1	Amending the act of June 19, 2002 (P.L.377, No.56), entitled "An	
2	act authorizing the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to join the	
3	Interstate Compact for the Supervision of Adult Offenders;	
4	providing for the form of the compact; imposing additional	
5	powers and duties on the Governor, the Secretary of the	
6	Commonwealth and the Compact Administrator; and making a	
7	repeal," establishing the Interstate Compact for the	<
8	Supervision of Adult Offenders Fund; imposing an application	
9	fee; providing for the collection of the application fee;	
10	imposing additional powers and duties on the State Council	
11	for Interstate Adult Offender Supervision, including the	
12	distribution of the moneys in the fund; IMPOSING AN	<
13	APPLICATION FEE; PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION AND THE USE OF	
14	THE APPLICATION FEE; and providing for definitions.	
15	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania	
16	hereby enacts as follows:	
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17	Section 1. The act of June 19, 2002 (P.L.377, No.56), known	
10	as the Interstate Compast for the Conservation of Adult Offendars	
18	as the Interstate Compact for the Supervision of Adult Offenders	
19	Act, is amended by adding a section to read:

20	Section 4.1. Interstate Compact for the Supervision of Adult	
21	Offenders Fund FEE.	<
22	(a) Fund established. The Interstate Compact for the	<
23	Supervision of Adult Offenders Fund is hereby established as a	

- 1 restricted receipts account within the General Fund. Moneys from
- 2 the fund shall be used exclusively for the purposes described in
- 3 this section.
- 4 (b) (A) Application fee.--

5 (1) Any person on county probation or parole who applies

- 6 for a transfer of supervision to another state through the
- 7 interstate compact shall be required to pay an application
- 8 fee with each application for transfer, unless the court
- 9 <u>finds that the application fee should be reduced, waived or</u>
- 10 deferred based upon the person's inability to pay. All such
- 11 <u>application fees shall be collected by the county probation</u>
- department or other agent designated by the county
- commissioners of the county with the approval of the
- 14 <u>president judge.</u>
- 15 (2) Any person on State probation or parole who applies
- for a transfer to another state through the interstate
- 17 compact shall be required to pay an application fee to the
- 18 board with each application for transfer, unless the board
- 19 finds that the application fee should be reduced, waived or
- 20 <u>deferred based upon the person's inability to pay.</u>
- 21 (c) (B) Amount of application fee.--The State council shall
- 22 establish the amount of the application fee but the fee shall
- 23 not exceed \$150. The application fee shall be nonrefundable. The
- 24 application fee shall be assessed for each application for
- 25 transfer to another state.
- 26 (d) (C) Application fee collected by county.--For
- 27 administrative expenses, the county shall be entitled to retain
- 28 <u>a percentage of each application fee collected under this</u>
- 29 <u>section</u>, which shall be deposited in the county's general fund.
- 30 The percentage of the application fee that may be retained shall

- 1 be determined by the State council 60 days prior to the
- 2 beginning of each Commonwealth fiscal year commencing on July 1
- 3 and ending on June 30. All of the remaining portion of each
- 4 application fee collected by the county shall be deposited into
- 5 the fund.
- 6 (e) Application fee collected by board. All of each
- 7 application fee collected by the board under this section shall
- 8 be deposited into the fund.
- 9 (f) Disbursement. The State council shall allocate and
- 10 disburse the moneys in the fund to offset or pay for the:
- 11 <u>(1) Annual assessments on the Commonwealth for</u>
- 12 <u>participation in the interstate compact.</u>
- 13 <u>(2) Administrative and operational expenses incurred</u>
- 14 because of the Commonwealth's participation in the interstate
- 15 <u>compact.</u>
- 16 <u>(3) Fines, fees or costs imposed by the interstate</u>
- 17 <u>commission pursuant to the interstate compact.</u>
- 18 TRANSMITTED TO THE COMMONWEALTH UNDER SUBSECTION (D).
- (D) DISPOSITION. -- MONEYS RECEIVED FROM THE COLLECTION OF THE

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- 20 APPLICATION FEE SHALL BE PAID INTO THE STATE TREASURY AND SHALL
- 21 BE CREDITED TO THE GENERAL GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS OF THE BOARD
- 22 FOR EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE COMPACT.
- (q) (E) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following <-
- 24 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 25 subsection:
- 26 "Board." The Pennsylvania Board of Probation and Parole.
- 27 "Fund." The Interstate Compact for the Supervision of Adult <
- 28 <u>Offenders Fund.</u>
- 29 "Interstate commission." The Interstate Commission for Adult
- 30 <u>Offender Supervision.</u>

- 1 "Interstate compact." The Interstate Compact for the
- 2 <u>Supervision of Adult Offenders.</u>
- "State." A state of the United States, the District of 3
- 4 Columbia and any other territorial possessions of the United
- 5 States.
- "State council." The State Council for Interstate Adult 6
- 7 Offender Supervision.
- Section 2. This act shall apply to any person who applies on 8
- 9 or after the effective date of this act for a transfer of
- 10 supervision to another state.
- 11 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
