AN ACT

Amending the act of September 9, 1965 (P.L.497, No.251), 2 entitled "An act requiring physicians, hospitals and other institutions to administer or cause to be administered tests for phenylketonuria and other metabolic diseases upon infants 4 in certain cases, "further defining "disease"; and providing 6 for testing for severe combined immunodeficiency. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. The definition of "disease" in section 2 of the 10 act of September 9, 1965 (P.L.497, No.251), known as the Newborn 11 Child Testing Act, added July 9, 1992 (P.L.398, No.86), is 12 amended to read: 13 Section 2. Definitions .-- The following words and phrases 14 when used in this act shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise: 15 16 17 "Disease."
