AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, imposing a temporary moratorium upon certain taxes.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Sections 9004, 9010, 9502 and 9511 of Title 75 of
6 the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended by adding
7 subsections to read:

8 § 9004. Imposition of tax, exemptions and deductions.

9 * * *

10 (i) Moratorium.--

11 (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section
12 to the contrary, a moratorium is imposed on the collection of
13 any tax or portion thereof imposed by this section which is
14 not required to be forwarded to a county or other
15 municipality.

16 (2) This subsection shall expire 90 days from the date
17 on which it takes effect.

1 § 9010. Disposition and use of tax.

2 * * *

3 (f) Moratorium.--

4 (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section
5 to the contrary, a moratorium is imposed on the collection of
6 any tax or portion thereof imposed by this section which is
7 not required to be forwarded to a county or other
8 municipality.

9 (2) This subsection shall expire 90 days from the date
10 on which it takes effect.

11 § 9502. Imposition of tax.

12 * * *

13 (1) Moratorium.--

14 (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section
15 to the contrary, a moratorium is imposed on the collection of
16 any tax or portion thereof imposed by this section which is
17 not required to be forwarded to a county or other
18 municipality.

19 (2) This subsection shall expire 90 days from the date
20 on which it takes effect.

21 § 9511. Allocation of proceeds.

22 * * *

23 (i) Moratorium.--

24 (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section
25 to the contrary, a moratorium is imposed on the collection of
26 any tax or portion thereof imposed by this section which is
27 not required to be forwarded to a county or other
28 municipality.

29 (2) This subsection shall expire 90 days from the date
30 on which it takes effect.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
