- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, eliminating the statute
- of limitations for certain civil actions and sex offenses.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 5530.1. Limitation for life of victim.
- 9 Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter except
- 10 sections 5521 (relating to limitations on foreign claims) and
- 11 5531 (relating to no limitation), a civil action against a
- 12 person or other entity for damages resulting from a violation of
- 13 any of the following provisions of 18 Pa.C.S. (relating to
- 14 crimes and offenses) may be commenced at any time during the
- 15 life of the victim if the victim was less than 14 years of age
- 16 at the time of commission of the criminal offense and the
- 17 criminal offense was committed on or after the effective date of
- 18 this section:

- 2 <u>Section 3122.1 (relating to statutory sexual assault).</u>
- 3 <u>Section 3123 (relating to involuntary deviate sexual</u>
