7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Section 1401 of the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103,
10	No.69), known as The Second Class Township Code, reenacted and
11	amended November 9, 1995 (P.L.350, No.60) and amended February
12	21, 2002 (P.L.100, No.9), is amended to read:
13	Section 1401. County Associations(a) County associations
14	of township officials may be formed. County associations shall
15	hold annual or semi-annual conventions at places determined by
16	the association to consider and discuss questions and subjects
17	pertaining to improvement of township government, assessment of
18	property, collection of taxes and construction, improvement and
19	maintenance of roads. Associations of two or more adjacent

1 counties may arrange to meet in joint sessions.

(b) The supervisors, auditors, assessors, tax collectors, 2 3 managers, solicitors, engineers, treasurer and secretary of the 4 board of supervisors shall attend the conventions when possible. 5 (c) (1) Each supervisor, auditor, assessor, tax collector, manager, solicitor, engineer, treasurer and secretary attending 6 the convention shall receive a certificate, signed by the 7 secretary of the county association, attesting their presence at 8 the convention. The certificate entitles the official to collect 9 10 from the township treasurer the sum of [thirty-five dollars 11 (\$35)] <u>fifty dollars (\$50)</u> for each day's attendance, expenses which are limited to the registration fee, mileage for use of a 12 13 personal vehicle or reimbursement of actual transportation 14 expense going to and returning from the meeting plus all other 15 actual expenses that the board of supervisors agrees to pay. 16 Every delegate attending the meeting shall submit to the board 17 of supervisors an itemized account of expenses incurred at the 18 meeting.

19 (2) If the meeting is held during township employes' normal 20 work schedule, the board of supervisors may authorize township 21 employes to be compensated at their regular employe rate during 22 their attendance at the meeting, in which case the employe is 23 not entitled to the [thirty-five dollars (\$35)] <u>fifty dollars</u> 24 <u>(\$50)</u> mentioned in this section.

25 (3) The board of supervisors may authorize a supervisor who 26 is not employed by the township to receive total or partial 27 reimbursement for lost wages or salary while attending the 28 annual meeting, in which case the supervisor is not entitled to 29 the [thirty-five dollars (\$35)] <u>fifty dollars (\$50)</u> mentioned in 30 this section, provided that sufficient documentation of such 20060S1114B1715 - 2 - wages or salary is presented to the board of supervisors to
justify the reimbursement.

3 (4) No supervisor, auditor, assessor, tax collector, 4 manager, solicitor, engineer, treasurer or secretary shall be 5 paid for more than two days' attendance in any one year. 6 (d) The officers of the association shall consist of a 7 president, one or two vice-presidents, a secretary and a treasurer, all of whom, except the secretary, shall be members 8 of the association and shall hold office for one year or until 9 10 their successors are chosen. The secretary of the association 11 may be compensated for services an amount determined by the members of the association. Every supervisor, assessor, tax 12 13 collector, manager, secretary, treasurer and auditor attending 14 the convention may vote on policy matters and in the election of officers of the association. 15

16 (e) Expenses of each county association convention shall be 17 paid from dues assessed by the association on each member 18 township or from other funds as the members of the county 19 association determine.

(f) Each county association of township officials may elect 20 21 one township supervisor, township manager, township treasurer or 22 township secretary for each ten townships, or fraction thereof, within the county, as a voting delegate to each annual meeting 23 of the State association, but each county association is 24 25 entitled to a minimum of two delegates at each meeting. These 26 delegates' expenses may be paid by the respective county 27 association.
