1 2 3	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for methamphetamine laboratories.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	§ 7508.2. Methamphetamine laboratories.
9	(a) Offense defined
10	(1) A person commits the offense of operating a
11	methamphetamine laboratory if the person knowingly causes a
12	chemical reaction involving ephedrine, pseudoephedrine or
13	phenylpropanolamine or any of their salts, optical isomers or
14	salts of optical isomers for the purpose of manufacturing
15	methamphetamine or preparing a precursor substance for the
16	manufacture of methamphetamine.
17	(2) Except as provided in subsection (c), an offense

1	under this subsection constitutes a felony.
2	(b) Drug-free school zoneA person who violates subsection
3	(a) commits a felony if the chemical reaction occurs within
4	1,000 feet of the real property on which is located a public,
5	private or parochial school, a college or university or a
б	nursery school or day care center, or within 250 feet of the
7	real property on which is located a recreation center or
8	playground and shall be sentenced as provided in section 6317
9	(relating to drug-free school zones).
10	(c) ExclusionThis section does not apply to the
11	manufacturing operation of a licensed pharmaceutical company in
12	the normal course of business.
13	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
